Eddie Owen made a motion to nominate Ashley Lynch as Chair of DPAC. Louis Tseng seconded the motion. All voted in favor.


Eddie Owen made a motion to nominate James Mack as Vice Chair of DPAC. Eva Kuhn seconded the motion. All voted in favor.


Questions/Comments
