BUSINESS ITEMS

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

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COMMISSION DISCUSSION ITEMS

Mural Update

Ashley updated the committee on the murals.

Brenda Ehly's site on Hill Street has been pressured washed and she have a website where people can volunteer to help with the mural. Ashley will get that link and send to Kris to forward to everyone. Brenda is rolling the masonry sealer this Friday.

The Bunten Park mural will be start the first weekend in May (5th and 6th). Ashley will contact the artist to check to see if pressure washing is needed on the tunnel. Kris will check on a quote to have the tunnel pressure washed the week prior to that if it is needed. Kim will check and make sure that the dates of the 5th and 6th are OK with the park for the tunnel to be closed.

The PIB mural was not approved at this time by the county due to the word "Duluth" being in the design. The commission has decided to wait while more conversation is had to see if they allow city names in murals. Marsha will keep the commission updated on the conversations and Ashley will update the artist.

Phoenix Plaque Update

Ashley presented plaques estimates to the committee. James Mack will have a quote and ideas for the Phoenix plaque in stainless steel cut by next Wednesday to the group. Ashley will use A1signs for the DPAC/sponsor sign and will use the Fossil CHPL material. We will e mail proofs to the group for approval.

We will also start looking at forming official sub-committees, so please think on what sub-committees you would like formed.
