**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

## COMMISSION DISCUSSION ITEMS

### Minute for the Arts

Each member shared a recent art experience or recommended an upcoming art event to the group.

### Phoenix Plaque Update

Ashley presented plaque estimates to the committee for stainless steel. The sign from A1 signs will be 8x22 and 1/8 thick stainless steel. It will be \$725 plus \$225 instillation and \$30 shipping. It will take 5 weeks from start to install. **Eddie Owen made a motion for A1 signs to complete the sign per the quote of \$725 plus \$225 instillation and \$30 shipping for the Phoenix. Eva Kuhn seconded the motion. All voted in favor.**

### Mural Update

Ashley updated the committee on the murals. Brenda Ehly's Hill Street and the Bunten Park mural have been completed. The county has not approved the Duluth mural on PIB yet so the group would like to work on a plan B. **Louis Tseng made a motion to reach out to the artists that originally submitted to the RFP with new criteria for the PIB wall. Eddie Owen seconded the motion. All voted in favor.**

### Subcommittee Discussion

Kris reviewed the list of subcommittees that had been previously compiled with the group. Eddie Owen will be in charge of Recruitment/Membership. (Kim will have it posted in the next 2 e-blasts that we are looking for DPAC members). Eva Kuhn will discuss with Matigan and possibly be in charge of the art catalog and art maintenance. Kris McGregor is handling developer sponsorship meetings at this time, we will put the fundraising on hold for the time being. Kim Jackson will be the liaison with our public relations department and work on the website page. Louis Tseng will be in charge of looking at the PAMP to determine what projects we need to look into to complete our art portfolio to achieve our PAMP goals.

### Woodcarving/Tree Sculpture

Ashley relayed to the commission his discussions with the tree artists he has found. Ashley will reach back out to SKA and ask their students for ideas for the carving.

### Other/Comments


Kris will talk with Ken about starting the financial report to present to council.
