BUSINESS ITEMS

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

COMMISSION DISCUSSION ITEMS

Project Update

Ashely updated the group on the tree bench project. The original budget was \$9,750 and is now going to be \$13,000. Ashley asked the group if they would like to continue with the project with the raise in price, even with the money already spent that cannot be recouped. The commission decided to stop the project because of the price increase and spend the remaining money on other projects.

Ashley, Kris and Olivia have visited Rogers Bridge with several metal work artists to get an idea on the scope and ideas for the project. Ashely has found a place for the metal to be stored until it is collected by the artist. There is also a State Farm Grant that would go towards this project.

The commission is discussing ideas on uses for the Parsons Bricks. Ashley is going to look into ideas for uses on these bricks.

By-Law Discussion

The group discussed changes to the by-laws for the commission to be presented to the council.

Greg Whitlock made a motion to recommend to council a change to the by-laws as discussed, Eva Kuhn Seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The commission would also like a 75% attendance policy be added to the ordinance for DPAC and presented to council.

Eddie Owen made a motion to recommend to council an attendance amendment to the DPAC ordinance as discussed, Eva Kuhn Seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

Time Change for the Meetings


Staff presented the idea of moving the time of the meetings earlier to be in line with council meetings. The group would like to wait until new appointments of members before that is decided.


Questions/Comments
