Future Project Discussions

The commission also needs to look at the catalog and get ideas on the instruments they like and the pricing and what they would like to spend on this project.

The commission wants to look into another mural at the railroad underpass at Sugarloaf Parkway. Staff will check on who the contact will be for the bridge, Norfolk Southern or the County.

Eddie Owen suggested a project on the back of the Red Clay Theater. There are 3 large plywood sections that cover old windows and he would like those turned into an art piece since they are more visible to Buford Highway now that the trees have been removed at the back of the building.

Woodcarving Update

Ashley updated they group on the progress of the project. He is meeting with one more artist hopefully in the next few days. The commission decided on a location on George Rogers.

Outreach Presentation

James Mack presented to the group his ideas on public engagement for DPAC. He would like to find a way to find a way to do temporary displays of public art that the community is involved in. The commission asked him to come back with 3 ideas, have a list of materials and the cost of each project for the next meeting. We need to think of the funding for the meet and greet and for community outreach before the next meeting.


Service Project
