

**Advertisement for Bids  
Asphalt Rejuvenation**

**The City of Duluth is accepting sealed bids from qualified contractors to provide all necessary labor, material and equipment necessary to perform all operations for the application of an asphalt rejuvenating agent to asphalt concrete surfaces. The rejuvenation of surface courses shall be by spray application of a cationic rejuvenating agent composed of petroleum oils and resins emulsified with water. All work shall be in accordance with the specifications, the applicable drawings and subject to the terms and conditions of this contract.**

A proposed list of streets is included in the full Invitation to Bid available at [www.duluthga.net](http://www.duluthga.net) under the heading "Notices and RFP's". The roads shown on the proposed list are intended locations. During the life of the contract it may become necessary to remove one or more locations from the list, it may also be necessary to add one or more locations to the list. It is the City of Duluth's intention to stay within total contract cost; therefore work may stop when the total cost reaches or nearly reaches the awarded amount. The final decision will be made as work progresses. The City of Duluth reserves the right to such. No claims will be considered for extra compensation.

All sealed bids will be received by the City of Duluth City Clerk, 3167 Main Street, Duluth, Georgia 30096, until **9:45 A.M. local time on Tuesday, April 2, 2019** . **Bids received after the stated time will not be accepted.** Bids will be opened publicly and read aloud on **Tuesday, April 2, 2019 at 10:00 A.M.** on the second floor of Duluth City Hall, 3167 Main Street, Duluth GA 30096, in the Executive Conference Room. The bid envelope must be marked on the outside with the following information:

There will **not** be a pre-bid conference for this procurement.

Contract will be awarded, if at all, within sixty (60) calendar days after opening of the proposal.

The deadline for questions is Tuesday, March 26, 2019 at 5 P.M. Submit all questions to Audrey Turner, Public Works Director at [aturner@duluthga.net](mailto:aturner@duluthga.net)

The selected contractor must be able to start work within ten (10) calendar days after the “Notice to Proceed” is issued. The time of completion for the project is ninety (90) calendar days from the date of the “Notice to Proceed”.

All bids shall be accompanied by a bid bond in favor of the City, in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid, (but not less than \$5,000); such bid bond representing that the bidder, if awarded a contract, will promptly enter into a contract and furnish performance bond and payment bond as provided by law and approved by the attorney for the City. **Failure to submit a bid bond with the proper rating will result in the bid being deemed non-responsive.**

Successful bidder will be required to meet insurance requirements. Performance and Payment bonds will be required upon acceptance of the proposal and contract submittal.

**The Performance Bond shall be equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount. The Payment Bond shall be equal to one hundred ten percent (110%) of the contract amount.**

Insurance and Bonding Company must be licensed to do business by the Georgia Secretary of State, authorized to business in Georgia by the Georgia Insurance Department, listed in the Department of Treasury’s Publication of Companies holding Certificates of Authority as Acceptable Surety on Federal Bonds and as acceptable reinsuring companies. **The bid bond, payment bond and performance bond must have an A.M. Best rating of A-5 or higher.**

Award will be made to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder. The City of Duluth reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive technicalities and to make an award as deemed in its best interest.

Any change to the conditions and specifications must be in the form of a written addendum to be valid; therefore the City will issue a written addendum to document each approved change.
