

CRIME SCENE INVESTIGATOR/TECHNICIAN

Duluth Police Department

The City of Duluth, Georgia (pop. 27,000) is accepting applications for the position of CRIME SCENE INVESTIGATOR/TECHNICIAN in the Duluth Police Department to fill an open position in our crime lab.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF DUTIES:

The Crime Scene Investigator/Technician is responsible for the identification, documentation, collection, processing, and classification of evidence from crime scenes which will lead to the arrest and prosecution of responsible parties. Work involves the transport, secure storage, and disposal of all evidence and property as determined by department policy and from crime scenes or to and from court as needed. The Crime Scene Investigator/Technician must participate in public relations and crime prevention activities by attending civic club meetings, schools, or other places of gathering occasionally on request. This position requires the investigator to be "on-call" as needed. Additionally, the investigator must be Georgia P.O.S.T. Certified, or be willing to become Georgia P.O.S.T. Certified as a Police Officer. It is preferred that applicants have completed the Crime Scene Technician Program and are certified as a Crime Scene Technician through Georgia P.O.S.T.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Age 18 or older
- High School Diploma or State-Issued GED
- Georgia P.O.S.T. Certified as a Crime Scene Technician
- In good standing with P.O.S.T. in all states of certification
- Georgia Driver's License within 30 days of hire if you currently hold an out-of-state valid license
- Be physically and mentally able to perform the essential job functions as listed in the job description

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Some college preferred
- Georgia P.O.S.T. Certified or Graduate of a Georgia Law Enforcement Academy preferred, but will consider sending otherwise highly qualified candidates to the police academy.

BACKGROUND HIRING INVESTIGATION:

All applicants are subject to an extensive background investigation, including criminal history background, drug testing, vision/hearing/medical exam, psychological evaluation, and polygraph.

PAY RANGE:

Starting pay range is: \$18.91 - \$20.83 per hour, (\$39,333 – \$43,326 annualized). Hiring pay rate is based on qualifications including specific experience, foreign language skills, and training/certifications.
