ORDER

Pursuant to the Judicial Emergency declared on March 14, 2020 by Chief Justice Harold D. Melton of the Georgia Supreme Court and to protect public health of court employees and court users, all visitors entering the courtroom shall respond to the following screening statements:

\_\_\_\_\_ I attest that I have not traveled to a high-risk area or location identified as a "hot spot" of confirmed coronavirus (COVID-19) cases within the last 14 days.

\_\_\_\_\_ To the best of my knowledge, I have not had contact with a person confirmed or presumed to have coronavirus (COVID-19) within the last 14 days.

\_\_\_\_\_ I attest that I have not experienced any difficulty breathing or persistent cough within the last 14 days. I further attest that, within the last 14 days, I have not experienced at least two of the following symptoms: fever, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell.

\_\_\_\_\_ To the best of my knowledge, I am not currently experiencing any upper respiratory illnesses accompanied by a fever.

\_\_\_\_\_ I affirm that I have not tested positive for the coronavirus (COVID-19) according to a confirmed test from a medical provider or pharmacy within the last 14 days.
