

Davenport Road Extension (CD – 55)

This project will create a new intersection and corresponding road at Buford Highway and the existing Davenport Road, adjacent to the Duluth Public Safety Center. The new Davenport Road extension west will link to Main Street and create a downtown transportation grid complete with turning lanes, sidewalks, signage, lighting, and curb and gutter. The new roadway will seamlessly incorporate a planned 13 acre downtown neighborhood. City staff is actively working with Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) and Norfolk Southern Railroad to coordinate the exact design and location of the roadway. Construction is anticipated to begin in coordination with the future downtown residential neighborhood. This project is being funded by the 2009 and 2014 SPLOST. The project is currently in the Engineering and Design phase, which is 30% complete.

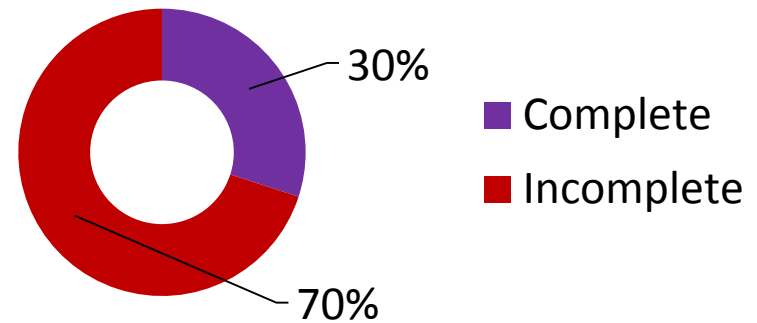
